

Frank Burrows - medical History

Frank was examined on 21st June 1917 at a declared age of 40 years and 8 months.

He was a Platelayer.

Height: 5 feet 8¼

Weight: 150lbs

Chest measurement: 40½ inches with expansion of 4 inches.

He had three vaccination marks on his left arm.

He had 6/6 vision in the right eye and 5/6 in the left.

Colour of hair: dark brown.

Table II shows he spent 23 days in the Military Hospital, Grimsby from 10/02/1917 until 1/1/1918 with a knee problem (script not readable)

Casualty form raised on enlistment. Regiment given as 5th battalion Sherwood Foresters and service to "duration of the war". He had joined at the Derby depot (April 1917) and "proceeded overseas on 06/03/1918", embarking at Folkestone on the 8th and disembarking at Boulogne the same day. He arrived in Calais on the 9th where he was posted to the 7th Sherwood Foresters. On 13th March he was posted to the 1st battalion "in the field".

Battalion form shows:

No date - joined

18/3/1917 - missing (rubber stamp)

Died on 30th March, place of casualty ?Norstad? - unreadable.

Is a form completed after he had been killed giving details of where his belongings were to be sent - to Mary Flowers of 7 Moor Lane, Bingham. The form is dated February 1919 and instructions carried out by the Lichfield depot.
