*James and Jane both born in Bingham, and in 1851 were neighbours in Wigginton's Row as youngsters. The Smiths moved to Radcliffe where J&J were married and had son James. They then moved to Westwood, part of the major industrial community of Ironville in the Erewash Valley where William (Herbert's father) was born. and then back to Bingham. Presumably James moved to find work each time.

In grey -
In workhouse 1881 census but not other years
