A DARDANELLES VICTIM.

NATIVE OF BOTTESFORD.



The first Bottesford man to fall in the war is Percy Wm. Hind, A.B., of H.M.S. Inflexible, who was killed in action on March 18th, at the Dardanelles. We reproduce his photograph. Deceased's parents left Bottesford a few years ago to reside at Bingham (Notts.), but several of his relatives live at Bottesford, and the connection with that place of the family is intimate. The "parsonage-bell" of Bottesford Church was tolled for him on Tuesday. Deceased was in his 21st year. He was present, with his ship, at the engagement of the Falkland Islands, when Von Spee's Squadron was destroyed by Admiral Sturdee.
