James Prior Kirk

Adelaide Wortley, in her History of Bingham, wrote of James Prior Kirk_that he was born in Nottingham on September 9 1851. He loved the countryside and he lived in Bingham from 1891 to 1922, where he died on 19th December. His novels are Renie, Ripple and Flood, which is a story of the River Trent Forest Folk, Hyssop, A Walking Gentleman, Fortuna Chance, November, Loose Strife (both unpublished); his plays are Don Pedro the Cruel and Ware Aegis; and some poems.
