Living Relatives form

This is undated, but probably completed after his death as the form was used to identify who should receive the "[plaque and scroll](#)".

Father Samuel Marriott was now at Nottingham Road Bingham and his mother in Leicester Borough

Asylum. Samuel moved after 1911 and before 1916.

Full blood brothers were: Joseph 28 at Salonika, Samuel 26 at [?], Frederick 23, Robert 16 and Arthur 14. The last three at Nottingham Road.

Full blood sisters were: Miriam Cowdell, 32, Chapel Yard, Bingham; Meg Marriott, 25 Bingham and Mary Marriott, 21 WRNS Tripoli.

Image 2 is the form advising the regiment of the address to which George's effects should be sent – to his father of Nottingham Road Bingham.

Image 3 is the list of his effects – 1 tin containing shaving brush, safety razor, bank book No 2585. Receipt of these was acknowledged by his father on September 22 1917.
