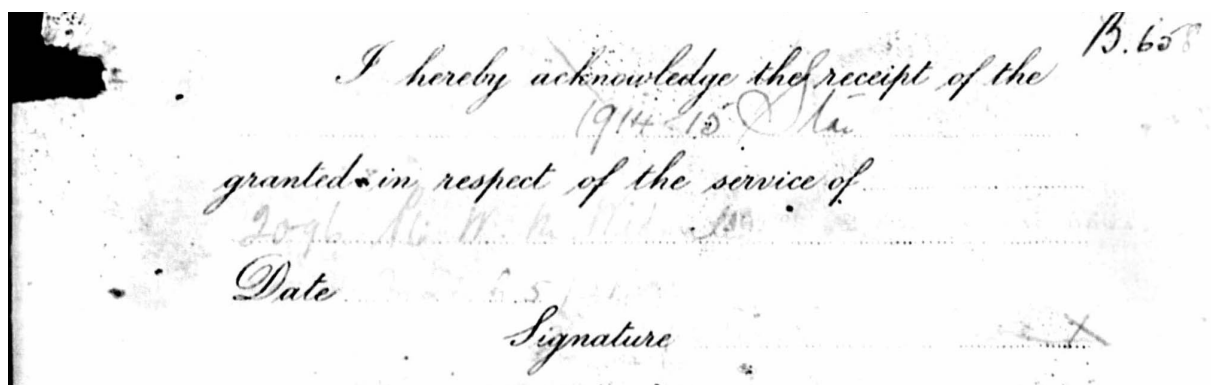
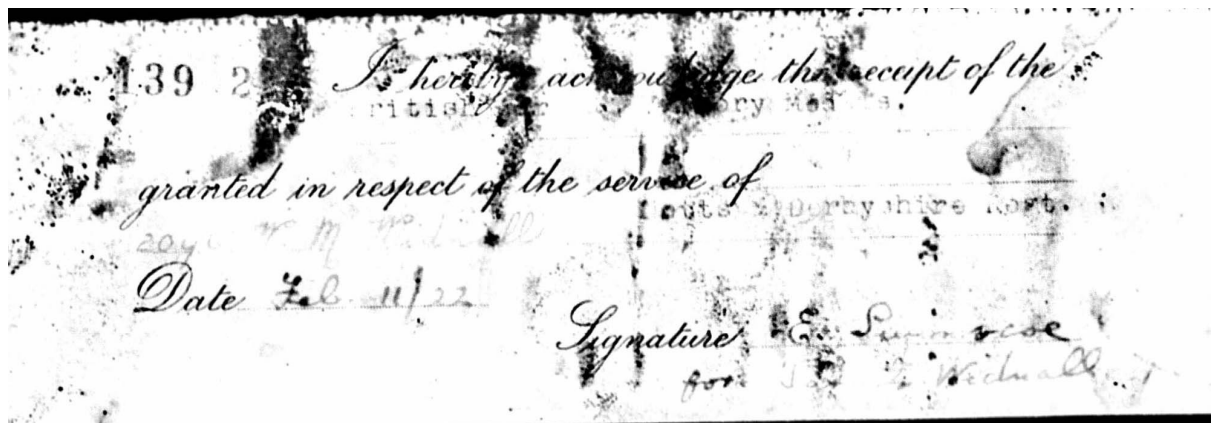
Receipt for his British Victory medals was signed by E Swinscoe on behalf of William's mother, Sarah. Swinscoes ran a carriage building and cycle repair works behind what is now the Co-op. Sarah signed the the receipt for the 1914-5 Star with her mark (X).

The form for recording next of kin to soldiers who had died showed him not to have a widow or children. Next of kin was his mother, now of 43 Ewart Road, Nottingham. The section showing other relatives is damaged. The form was signed by Sarah on 10th may 1919 and was witnessed by a surgeon named William Scott, MD, of 75 Radford Boulevard, Nottingham.
