## BINGHAM.

**TROWING STONES AT TELEGRAPH POLES**—Considerable damage has been caused to insulator on telegraph posts on the Fosse-road by stone-throwing, and on Thursday Charles Shepperson, Fredk. Cabourn, and Walter Gamble, all Bingham youths, appeared at the local Police-court. P.c. Sears stated that he saw the defendants throwing stones at the telegraph poles, but could not say whether, on that occasion, any insulators were broken. According to a postal telegraph linesman, thirty insulators were broken just about the time the defendants were seen by the constable. The lads denied throwing at the telegraphic apparatus at all, and declared that they only throw a few stones into the hedge bottom. They were each ordered to pay 5s.
