Either Mary, Jane or Ann married a Mr Blood and went to Birmingham. None are in 1881 census anywhere. Their sons Samuel (1868) and Foster (1873) lived with Sarah their grandmother in 1881 and Sam with his uncle John in Station Street in 1891. Sam (Foster) Blood was innkeeper at the Crown in 1901.
