Research Note	The Returning Forces Fund lists three Cabourn brothers at the same Moor Lane address. In two cases the initials given correspond with known forenames. JF = John Frederick and A = Richard Alan, known as Alan. The third name was added by hand after the list was typed and the initial is indistinct but we assume refers to the third brother W(illiam) Eric. In 1939 he was in a separate household in Hucknall.
