| Research Note                             | The Returning Forces Fund lists three Cabourn brothers at the same Moor Lane address. In two cases the initials given correspond with known forenames. JF = John Frederick and A = Richard Alan, known as Alan. The third name was added by hand after the list was typed and the initial is indistinct but we assume refers to the third brother W(illiam) Eric. In 1939 Eric was (a lodger) in a separate household in Hucknall in 1939. Hence, he had not been included in the original list but was probably added during or even after the war when he had returned to Bingham on being called up. |  |  |
