Research Note	The returning Forces Fund lists three Cabourn brothers at the same Moor Lane address. In two cases the initials given correspond with known forenames. JF = John Frederick and A = Richard Alan, known as Alan. The third name was added by hand after the list was typed and the initial is indistinct but we assume refers to the third brother W(illiam) Eric. No address was given for him; in 1939 he was a lodger in a household in Hucknall.		
War Service	John was in the army in WW II and fought in Italy where he was badly wounded. He would have been eligible for call up in July 1942. At some point he moved to Halifax and married Doris and had 2 daughters. He was still in the RE when he was married in 1947.
