J Lamb was listed as a furnace worker and C as a steam roller driver; both occupations fit with their 1939 register entries. In 1939 they would have been aged 30 and 21 respectively and presumably subject to conscription unless in reserved occupations or have health problems.		As Ernest is on the Returning Forces Fund list he may have joined up after 1942 when the work party lists were drawn up. John does not appear to have been called up.
