Post War	The Returning Forces Fund list indicates that James had left Bingham by the end of the war. He appears to have married and settled initially in Newcastle-upon-Tyne. Electoral registers and a private family Ancestry family tree suggest that at some point he moved to Ealing where he remarried in 1950. Hannah appears to have remained in Newcastle. At some point James returned to the East Midlands, dying in Rushcliffe.
