War Service	<p>In the 1942 lists of men available for <a href="#">working parties</a> etc both H Sheppard and E Sheppard are listed as available (although on the second list the name carried no initial). H Sheppard was assigned to a works servicers team led by foreman C Spawton and 'E' Sheppard was listed a road man suitable for work parties. Cherry Street was given as the contact address in both cases [see 1939 register below].</p> <p>Thus it would seem that Eddie was in Bingham in 1942 and not in the forces. Maybe he had heath issues or maybe he was in a reserved occupation. He was aged 24 and unmarried at the time and would normally have been subject to early conscription.</p>
